Two Things God Cannot Do (Part II)

Part I (Review):

God cannot love you *more* than He does now.

Part II:

God cannot love you <u>less</u> than He does now.

- A. **Nothing** can separate us from the love of Christ. (Rom 8:38-39)
 - What about <u>sin</u>?
 - Five sections of the letter to the Romans
 - 1. We have <u>sinned</u>. (1:1-3:20)
 - 2. God <u>saves</u> us. (3:21-5:21)
 - 3. God **grows** us. (6:1-8:39)
 - 4. God is in control. (9:1-11:36)
 - 5. God uses us. (12:1-16:27)
 - Everyone who trusts in Jesus Christ is **justified**. (Rom 3:23-25) Justified = found NOT guilty
 - Everyone who trusts in Jesus Christ is no longer **judged**. (Rom 8:1)
 - Can sin separate us from the love of Christ? <u>No</u>!
- B. Next time you fail (sin),
 - Remember you're _no longer judged!
 - <u>**Confess**</u> your sins to God as your <u>**Father**</u> (not as the Judge), and He will change you!
