Abnormal Christian Life

Romans 7:14-25 (Paul's struggle with sin)

Christian life struggling with sin = <u>Abnormal</u> Christian Life

- A. What is the normal Christian life?
 - is **<u>not</u>** a common life lived by many.
 - is a life lived according to <u>God's</u> plan/design.
- B. What is the normal Christian life like?
 - The letter to the Romans portraits it!
 - Focus of the letter to the Romans
 - Q: What is emphasized most in Romans?
 - A: <u>God</u>! (along with "Lord", "Christ" etc.)
 - The normal Christian life is not focused on **<u>ourselves</u>**.
 - The normal Christian life is focused on <u>God</u>.
 - Why? Because God is God and we are <u>not</u>.
- C. Romans 7:14-25 (abnormal Christian life)
 - Focus of this passage
 - Q: What is emphasized most in this passage?
 - A: The word " <u>I</u> "
 - We struggle with sin when we focus too much on **<u>ourselves</u>**.
