Reality is...

Matthew's Gospel 6:31-33 (NIV)

- A. "Do not worry! Seek **God** first!"
 - According to the Bible, "worry" means caring for something so much that it becomes your master
 - This passage (teaching) concerns not worrying about **financial** security or material **possessions** (Matt 6:31)
- B. But according to the **world** around us, reality is... "You need **money** first!"
 - In time of financial trouble, religion does not help you
 - After all, money is and should be our first concern
 - You need to have a "healthy" separation between religion and reality
- C. But according to **Jesus**, reality is... still "Seek **God** first!"
 - The teaching of the world around us is **nothing** new (Matt 6:32a)
 - God **knows** our financial and physical (and not just spiritual) needs (Matt 6:32b)
 - When we seek God, what we need <u>will</u> be provided (Matt 6:33)

 (Not may be provided or should be provided etc.)
 - It is the all-powerful **God** who will provide for us
 - Those who seek God's righteousness will be **satisfied** (Matt 5:6)
