"I will"

1. We need grace

- Grace is God's <u>favor</u> given to us while we do not <u>deserve</u> it and cannot <u>earn</u> it.
- The <u>Law</u> (God's commands and rules) was given to show that we <u>need</u> grace.
- We need grace to **become** Christians (Eph. 2:8-9).
- We need grace to <u>live</u> as Christians (1 Cor. 15:10).
- The gospel of grace is the gospel of **Jesus Christ** (John 1:14).

2. "I will"

- The "I will" statements of God in the Old Testament mean that it has always been <u>God</u> taking action for <u>us</u>. (Gen 12:2, 13:16, 17:7 etc.) → God's grace!
- In Christian life led by the grace of God, the "I will" statement belongs to **Jesus Christ**, and not to **us** (Gal. 2:20)
 - → Jesus will get the credit for His work!
- Our part is to <u>receive</u> God's grace and <u>allow</u> Him to work in us and through us.
