# "I Surrender All (Part I)"

### King:

One who rules over you and determines direction in your life.

Q1: Who (or what) is your king?

Q2: Is your life working?

### What does the Bible say about the "king"?

- $\rightarrow$  God is the King! (Psalm 24:8-10)
- → At first, Israel had no king. (Judges 21:25)
- → Then, people wanted a king other than God. (1 Samuel 8:5b)
- → God was not pleased with their request. (1 Samuel 8:7)

### **Christian life**

According to Dr. George Murray of Columbia International University,

- Christian life is <u>not</u> a <u>democracy</u>, but is a <u>monarchy</u>.
- Christian life is not a <u>constitutional</u> monarchy; Christian life is an <u>absolute</u> monarchy.

## **Surrendering to King**

- $\rightarrow$  <u>God</u> is the absolute King whom we are to allow <u>absolute reign over us</u>.
- → Surrendering all to God starts from understanding and allowing God's *absolute kingship over us*.
