"Follow me"

(Luke 5:1-11)

What does it mean to be a Christian?

- To believe and follow
- But what matters is not <u>what</u> you believe and follow, but <u>who</u> you believe and follow; Jesus Christ.

Observation of Luke 5:1-11

Peter was invited to follow Jesus when:

1. Peter was already <u>settled in life</u>.

- God calls you to follow Him even when you are <u>busy</u> working, and not being idle.
- God calls you to follow Him even when following Him may "cost" you.

2. Peter was convicted of his unworthiness of God's grace.

• You are ready to follow Jesus, not when you think you're good enough to follow Jesus, but when you realize you're not good enough.

3. It seemed <u>ridiculous</u> to follow Jesus.

- People around you might think you are crazy to follow Jesus.
- Following Jesus may be against all the wisdom, common sense, and value system you may have learned in your life until now.

Is it worth following Jesus?
Is Jesus worthy of following?
