"The End of Hope"

- I. Why hope?
- Because there is **need** for it!
- Because we live in a **fallen** world, and need hope to hold onto.
- II. Different degrees of hope
- 1. "Hopefully" hope
 - "I hope so" type of **subjective** feeling
- 2. "If it's God's plan" hope
 - No matter how unlikely it may seem, <u>anything</u> is <u>possible</u> if it is God's plan, desire and will. (Rom. 4:18)
- 3. Ultimate hope of eternal life
 - This is not just a hope for the **present** life, but is a hope for **heaven**.

 (1 Cor. 15:19)
 - This hope is an **objective** truth that God has promised. (Heb. 6:18)
 - This hope has an <u>end</u> to it (Heb. 6:11), and in heaven, our hope will no longer be hope, but will be <u>reality</u> (Rom. 8:24).
 - In heaven, there will be <u>no more need</u> for hope because it is a perfect world! (Rev. 21:4)
