"Are we pleading like David?"

Q: At the beginning of the year, do you want a fresh start for your life?

- King David wanted a fresh start!
 - When David committed great sins, what did he plead with God for?
 - "Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me." (Psalm 51:10-11 (NIV))
 - When your life is a mess, are you supposed to plead with God in the same way? → Yes and No!

Yes: We should confess our sins to God and seek His forgiveness of sins and cleansing.

No: <u>David was not wrong</u> to plead like that <u>during his time</u>, but <u>we would be</u> <u>wrong</u> to plead like that at the <u>present time</u>.

 \rightarrow The Holy Spirit, who used come and go, <u>stays</u> in us now and will <u>never leave us</u> anymore. (John 14:16-17a)

- There is more!
 - "The Holy Spirit also testifies to us about this. [...] Then he adds: "Their sins and lawless acts <u>I will remember no more</u>." (Heb. 10:15-17 (NIV))
 - God sees us as if we have never sinned before; God sees us as perfect, blameless, and spotless people. = We can <u>always</u> have a <u>fresh start</u>!

 \rightarrow This is because <u>Jesus</u> took all our sins and paid the penalty on the cross! (Heb. 10)

- Conclusion
 - 1. The Holy Spirit who lives in us will never leave us.
 - 2. God remembers our sins no more, so we can always have a fresh start!
