"Normal and Weird" (I Surrender All - Part III)"

Normal:

- Conforming to a standard; usual, typical, or expected
- <u>NOT</u> ordinary
- Being in proper shape; being how you should be

Weird:

• Very strange; bizarre

Surrendering all to God in current society means to be <u>normal</u> and <u>weird</u>.

1. If you live your life <u>entirely</u> for <u>Jesus Christ</u>, you are a <u>normal</u> Christian.

Normal Christian life = Life focused entirely on <u>Jesus Christ</u>.

2. If you live your life <u>entirely</u> for <u>Jesus Christ</u>, you are <u>weird</u> in this society.

In this society, Normal = Weird

Blind man healed by Jesus (John 9-10)

In Ch. 9, the healed man follows Jesus, and becomes cast out by society. In Ch. 10, which is a continuation of the occasion that took place in Ch. 9, Jesus' message is "I will take care of him."

If we live "normal" Christian life, this society will consider you "weird." But, *God will take care of you*.
